## Moraga Turns 40

Local Knowledge of Lamorinda & Extraordinary Results

orty years is a big milestone in anyone's life, and so it is for Morros which is for Moraga, which is preparing to celebrate its 40th birthday this year. A look at the reasons why residents decided it was important to incorporate offers perspective on the town's identity; although the pressing issues of the past were not that different from those the town is grappling with in the present. Seventy-three percent of the 8,434 registered voters

went to the polls in November, 1974, and after the ballots were counted the proponents of incorporation declared victory by a 60-40 margin. The first five Moraga Town Council members, elected from a pool of 13 candidates, took their seats on the dais.

Incorporation came after years of work by the Moraga Community Association, which was trying to curb the development that was supported by county administrators, despite residents who thought independence was not financially viable and would lead to the infringement of property owners' rights. ... continued on page A14
