Coming Soon: Parking Workshop and Thanksgiving Breakfast Event

Coming to Lafayette this week are a Parking Workshop, where the city hopes to gather residents' thoughts on parking strategies, and the annual Community Thanksgiving Breakfast, organized by the Chamber of Commerce - an opportunity to reflect on the community and give thanks. The workshop, sponsored by the City of Lafayette Parking Ordinance Committee, is from 6 to 8 p.m. on Thursday, Nov. 20 in the Community Room at the Lafayette Library and Learning Center, 3491 Mt. Diablo Blvd. Free, no reservation required, and complimentary snacks.
