In her presentation to the school plete, and established a guiding board, Associate Superintendent Aida Glimme outlined the GREC recommendations that could be phased in over time, but ultimately it is up to the board to accept, reject or modify these recommendations (see box below). Glimme estimates it would take a year to develop any new courses, and the administration does not want to penalize existing students, so new rules would only apply to incoming freshmen after plans and classes have been solidified.

## **GREC Recommended changes to AUHSD Graduation Requirements:**

- 1. Expand English 4 (12th grade) course offerings to include English electives
- 2. Expand PE 10 (10th grade) course offerings to include PE electives and PE through independent study for eligible students
- 3. Require one year of visual or performing arts
- 4. Require one semester of health (social psychology)
- 5. Require three years of math
