Fire at the Hacienda de las Flores

n the morning of March 9th heavy smoke started to seep through the roof of the Hacienda de las Flores, a Town-owned building that houses staff offices and space for community meetings and classes.

"The building was evacuated in very good order so no one was exposed to smoke," said Battalion Chief Randy Trompf, who arrived at the scene a few minutes later with his men. Since no flames were seen, the firefighters used thermal imaging cameras that had been donated by the Women's League, and were able to find the source inside the wall. The fire

was extinguished in a matter of minutes.

"The cause of the fire is still under investigation," said Trompf on March 12th. He was expecting a result within a week or two. "We need to find the reason for this fire," said Moraga Mayor Dave Trotter at the March 11th Town Council, "and act appropriately to prevent further occurrences."

According to Jill Mercurio, Moraga Town Engineer, the cost of repairs has not been determined and could range anywhere from \$10,000-\$50,000. The Town's insurance policy has a \$5,000 deductible.

Moraga Hires a Consultant to Help File its Housing Element **By Sophie Braccini**

ike all other California jurisdic-**∠**tions Moraga has to file, in the coming months, a plan showing how its buildable land will be zoned to accommodate the development of low and moderate income housing. Failure to comply with the State requirements could mean the loss of an annual allocation from the Transportation Agency; about \$250,000 for Moraga, per year.

The deadline for filing the report is the end of June and at the March 11 Council meeting, town staff recommended hiring Baird and Driskell Consultants to help in the process

on two major development projects with the help of only one part-time assistant. "We want to file our housing element as close as possible to the June deadline," said Mayor David Trotter. All the other Council Members agreed and voted unanimously to approve the contract.

The contract cost of \$67,000 includes discussion with the State agency that manages the process, public sessions, and the responses to both public and agency questions.
