"I was very excited to have the Rossmoor Big Band play for us one night to introduce them to the real thing and play the music we had been learning to dance to," Enright adds. "These were young 7th and 8th graders learning how to dance; I was most impressed with her efficiency. In a matter of moments she had the young dancers in motion and they seemed to very much enjoy the experience," concludes Levich.

Enright, who says she has been a Ballroom Dance instructor for most of her adult life, currently teaches classes at Rossmoor and is looking forward to the Big Band Dance. "I enjoy working with large groups," she explains, "and this will be another great opportunity to get people out on the dance floor!"
