The study looked at extending turn lanes on southbound Pleasant Hill Road, both for turning left onto Stanley Boulevard and right onto Deerhill Road It showed no benefit for the left hand lane and a limited benefit for the right hand turn toward Deerhill Road. Coe said that ex tending the right hand turn would allow roughly three extra allow rough href extra cars through on each traffic signal cycle or less than 50 extra vehicles an hour, which he said was not worth the expenditure

Perhaps the harder question is that of traffic on Reliez Val ley Road. Coe recommended the continued monitoring of traffic along the road and shared the consultant's suggestions of flashing speed feedback signs together with targeted speed enforcement.

Coe also suggested talking to the community-based navigation app, Waze, which still directs traffic along Reliez Valley Road as a bypass for Pleasant Hill Road.

Lafayette Police Chief Eric Christensen weighed in on the effectiveness of the speed feedback signs, saying that they have limited success and that drivers tend
