Once the light turned green, the same group of cars either eventually turned right onto Moraga Way or drove merrily along continuing south until a few, including MPD (with lights still flashing), made a left-hand turn onto Sanders Drive.

"Unfortunately, there are many times when drivers fail to yield to emergency vehicles that are being driven with the lights and siren activated," stated King. "Drivers are distracted, may not see the emergency vehicle, or may panic and

not know what to do ... or there may be other reasons. Regardless, this slows the response, which may not seem like a big deal, unless we are responding to your house for an emergency. It is also very important for officers, firefighters and EMS personnel to drive defensively when responding to an emergency as while we hope drivers will yield -- and many do -- but there are some who do not or make an abrupt movement that we have to avoid. If we get in an accident, we cannot get to the emergency and help whoever is in trouble or worse."
